

Lake Miyagase Area

The area surrounding the Lake Miyagase is managed by the national government, Kanagawa Prefectural Government and local municipalities through their concerted efforts, based on the idea to "create in the suburbs of major cities a resort area equipped with natural park functions with a view to realizing exchange and coexistence between man and nature, as well as between cities and regions". Specifically, in line with the policy to conserve nature as far as possible in the whole lakeside area, the development work was made for the three zones that possess large potentiality to enjoy the blessings of nature.

Service hours: 9:50 to 16:30
Service day: Weekends, holidays, Special water discharge day (out of service in normal days)
Charge: round trip 800 JPY (from Miyagase to dam site)
single way 500 JPY (from dam site to Toriibara)
single way 500 JPY (from Toriibara to Miyagase)

Miyagase Dam "Incline"
Service hours: 10:00 to 16:45 every 6 to 10 minutes
Non-service days: Mondays (the next day if it is holiday)
Charge: for adults, 300 JPY for round trip and 200 JPY for single way (half for children)



Miyagase Lakeside Park, road train "Miya"
Service hours: 10:00 to 16:30
Non-service days: Mondays (the next day if it is holiday)
Stop: 6 places besides "Observation Square"
Charge: 300 JPY for adults (200 JPY for children)



Prefectural Aikawa Park, road train "Ai"
Service hours: 10:00 to 16:20
Non-service days: Mondays (the next day if it is holiday)
Stop: "Front of Park Center", "Dam-Foot Stop"
Charge: 200 JPY for adults single way (half for children)

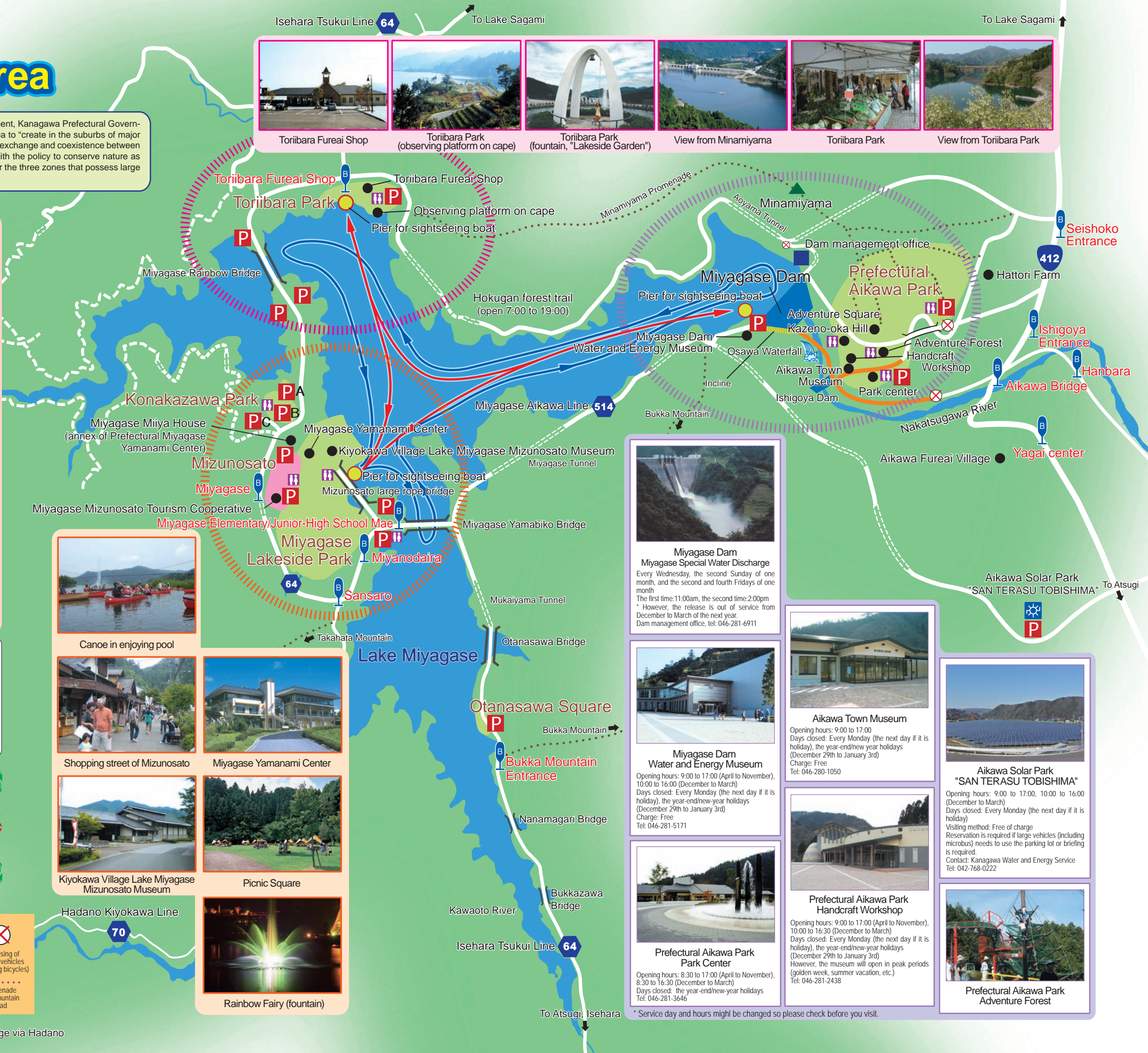
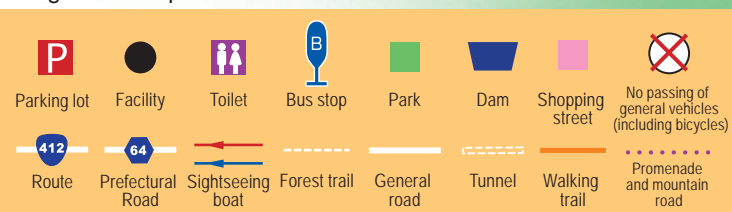
* From December 1st to March 31st, ① provides service on weekends and holidays only.

* Please check before using as the service hours, etc. may be changed due to situations.

- **Access to Miyagase Lakeside Park**
Take Kanachu Bus, "Miyagase" direction from Odakyu Line, Honatsugi Station and get off at the end, just nearby
- **Access to Prefectural Aikawa Park**
(1) Take Kanachu Bus, "Yagai Center via Hanbara" direction from Odakyu Line, Honatsugi Station, get off at "Aikawa Bridge", and walk for about 15 minutes
(2) Take Kanachu Bus, "Hanbara" direction from JR Fuchinobe Station, get off at the end, and walk for about 20 minutes
- **Access to Toriibara Park**
Take Kanachu Bus, "Toriibara Fureai Shop" direction from JR Hashimoto Station, and get off at the end, just nearby

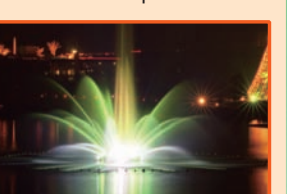

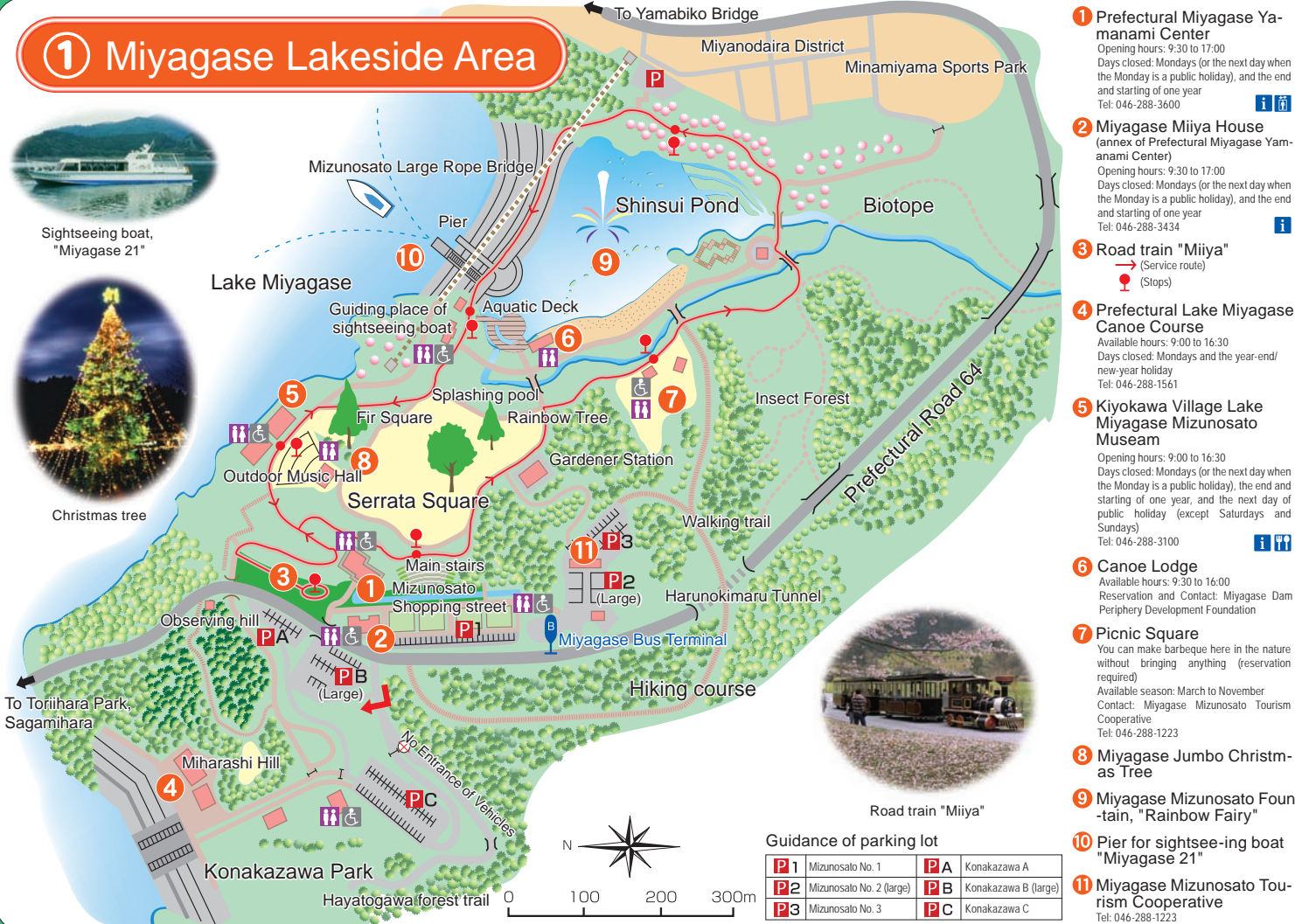

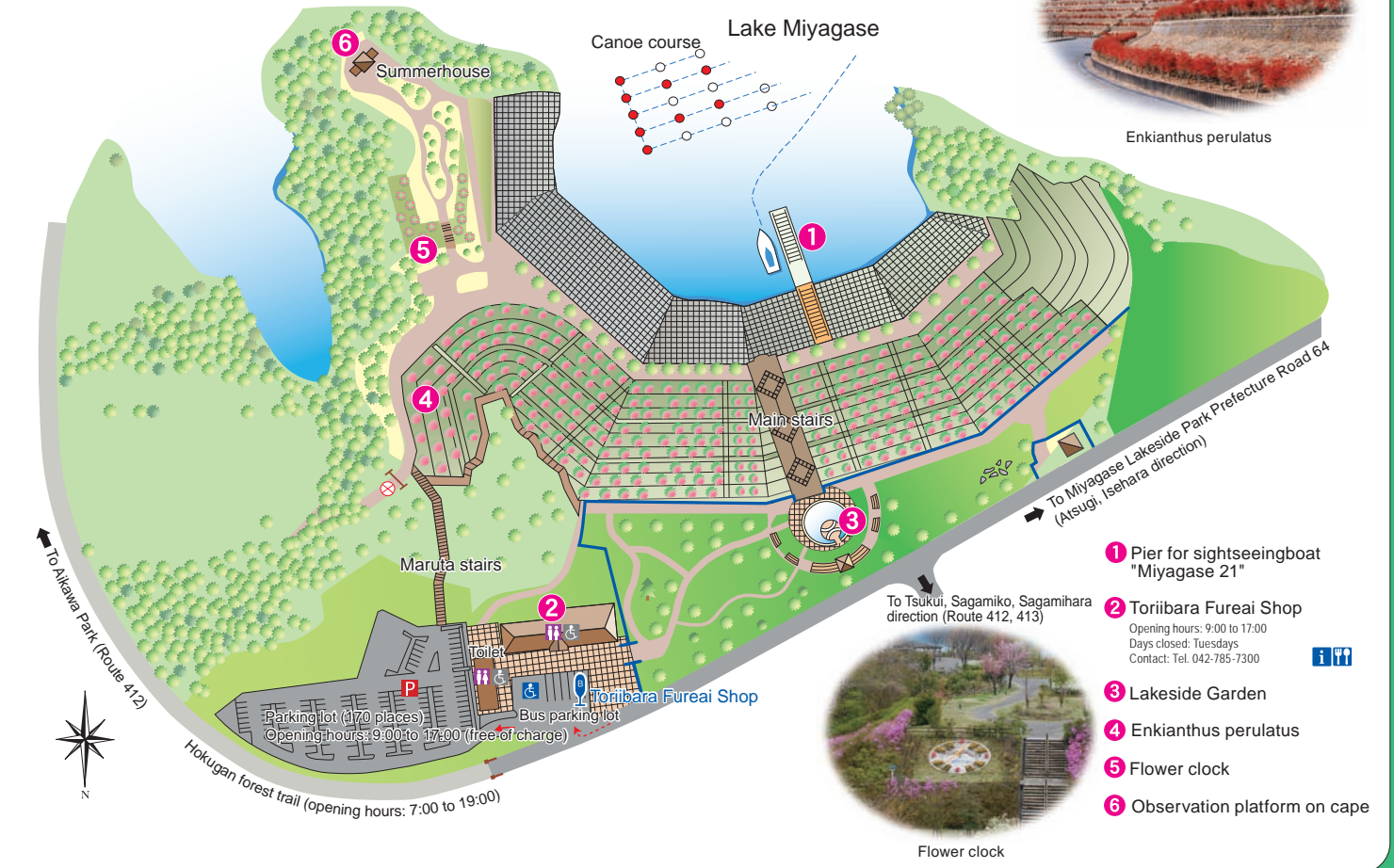
3-Area Map around Lake Miyagase
